
Make a garment of any era using the rationing restrictions of WWII

Any skill level, any style welcome. Hosted by Sew Biased, The Vintage Guidebook, and Thistle'n'Stitches

- Materials: Cotton, Rayon, Wool, no silk or Nylon, no Leather, metal, lace, embroidery, bows, braids, ruffles, non-functional buttons, elastic. (Except Recycled materials)
- Dresses: no more than 5 buttons at least 4" apart, no more than 2 box pleats or 4 knife pleats, no more than 2 pockets (no flaps), no more than 6 seams in the skirt, hems no more than 2", maximum length 45", maximum sweep of hem 74"
- Evening Dresses: Same as other dresses, maximum length 59", sweep of hem 144"
- Trousers: Maximum length 45", bottom width 14.5", no more than 2 pockets, no zippers, no turn up cuffs, no buttons on pockets
- Suit Jacket: No waistcoats/vests, no more than 25" from neck to hem, no more than 1.5" hems, no turn up cuffs, no more than 2 pockets, no more than 8 buttons, no double breasted jackets
- · Coats: Same as suit jackets, also Straight coat 44" in length, 64" sweep of hem, Fitted coat 45" in length, 64" sweep of hem, no epaulettes, capes
- Skirts: Length 30", sweep of hem 66", no more than 4 yards of stitching, no more than 2 pockets, no tiered skirts or all-round pleats, no more than 6 seams, no more than 2 box or 4 knife pleats

WORLD WAR 2 CHALLENGE

- Make a garment that meets the rationing rules of World War 2
- Any era, any style, any skill level welcome

MATERIALS

- Cotton, Rayon, Wool, no silk or Nylon, no leather
- No metal zippers, buttons, buckles, etc.
- No lace, embroidery, bows, braids, ruffles, non-functional buttons
- No elastic
- No more than 4 meters of stitching total

TROUSERS

- Maximum length 45", bottom width 14.5"
- No more than 2 pockets
- No zippers
- No turn-up cuffs
- · No buttons on pockets

(assuming UK size I2, adjust as needed)

DRESSES

- No more than 5 buttons, at least 4" apart
- No more than 2 box pleats or 4 knife pleats
- No more than 2 pockets (no flaps)
- No more than 6 seams in the skirt
- Hems no more than 2"
- Maximum length: 45", sweep of hem 74"

(assuming UK size I2, adjust as needed)

COATS

- Straight coat: 44" in length, 64" sweep of hem
- Fitted Coat: 45" in length, 64" sweep of hem
- No more than 2 pockets
- No more than 8 buttons
- No double-breasted jackets
- No epaulettes, capes, turn back cuffs

(assuming UK size I2, adjust as needed)

EVENING DRESSES

- No more than 5 buttons, at least 4" apart
- No more than 2 box pleats or 4 knife pleats, no pockets
- · No more than 6 seams in the skirt
- Hems no more than 2"
- Maximum length: 59", sweep of hem 144"

(assuming UK size I2, adjust as needed)

BLOUSES

- No more than I pocket
- No more than 7 buttons in longsleeve, 5 buttons on short sleeve
- No more than I button per cuff
- No epaulettes or capes
- Max sleeve width I4"
- Length from neck to hem 22"
- Prohibited styles: Dolman, balloon, and leg o'mutton

(assuming UK size I2, adjust as needed)

SUIT JACKET

- No waistcoats/vests
- No more than 25" from neck to hem
- No more than I.5" hems
- No turn-up cuffs
- No more than 2 pockets
- No more than 8 buttons
- No double-breasted jackets (assuming UK size I2, adjust as needed)

SKIRTS

- Length 30", sweep of hem 66"
- No more than 4 yards of stitching total
- No more than 2 pockets
- No tiered skirts or all-around pleats
- No more than 6 seams
- No more than 2 box or 4 knife pleats

(assuming UK size I2, adjust as needed)

PLEASE COME

- This list is not meant to be proscriptive - if you can't find the right fabric, we'd love to see you anyway
- Adjust for your body, and do your best. We'd rather see more people try this out than a few people who have to get it perfect!
